DAY 1: ENFORCEMENT OF FIRST NATION LAWS - FEDERAL AND PROVINCIAL ACTION PLANS

Focusing on federal and provincial action plans for enforcing First Nation laws.

- Opening remarks from the Lands Advisory Board, First Nations Land Management Resource Centre and federal and provincial Ministers.
- Federal and provincial Minister panel discussion on departmental action plans to support the enforcement and prosecution of First Nation laws.
- Updates on the progress of key federal and provincial Indigenous enforcement initiatives, including the codevelopment of federal First Nation Police Services legislation, changes to the BC Offences Act to include Treaty First Nations, and deliberations of the Ontario Tri-partite Collaborative Technical Table on the Enforcement and Prosecution of First Nation Laws.
- Expert Indigenous keynote address on how the reconciliation of First Nation laws with other legal systems in Canada will help rebuild First Nation self-government across the country.

DAY 2: FIRST NATION-LED PROGRESS ON ENFORCEMENT AND TRADESHOW

Focusing on First Nation-led enforcement initiatives and the launch of the tradeshow featuring businesses and organizations able to assist First Nations with their enforcement needs.

- First Nation presentations about partnerships, capacity-building strategies, and other initiatives to improve or advance enforcement and prosecution mechanisms on reserve.
- Update on First Nations Land Management Resource Centre strategies, supports and initiatives to resolve the enforcement issue.
- Keynote address from an Indigenous leader in enforcement on the importance of First Nation laws and First Nation-led justice systems
- Evening networking event and tradeshow.

DAY 3: INDIGENOUS POLICING SOLUTIONS AND TRADESHOW

Focusing on Indigenous policing services, solutions, and action plans, with further opportunities to explore the tradeshow.

- First Nation presentations on self-administered police services on reserve.
- Panel discussion by representatives from various policing agencies across Canada on policing solutions and action plans.
- International keynote address highlighting success stories, challenges, and initiatives in Indigenous Law Enforcement.
- Highlights of First Nation enforcement support tools and services from conference sponsors.
- Keynote address by an Indigenous expert in government relations on the actions needed to advance First Nation law enforcement solutions.
